2. Issues Discussed

Mike gave an update on behalf of the tournament sub-committee as per the set of minutes distributed. The coaches who were present gave their availability for helping on the 2 days. evenings as there was space to play however these should still be booked through Mike to ensure no clashes and that the school is aware. This is also the case for Saturday matches.

Paul Browne proposed a "boot swap" where players could donate their old boots, they would then be cleaned and made available for other members to borrow or even keep. A £1 donation would be suggested to cover the cost of cleaning materials. Any surplus boots would be donated to the BootsForAfrica cause. Everybody thought this was a good idea and Paul was going to implement it over the next week.
