7. Any Other Business

Martin updated everybody on a recent meeting held with the school in which a number of issues were discussed.

There is still an issue with a number of people driving too fast on site. The school are putting up 5mph signs as well as having a speed bump installed towards which the club will be paying half.

A tin cupboard is now in the hut with toiletries and cleaning products should anybody find that the toilets are short.

The school are very impressed with the ground work which was undertaken reporting that the people who did it worked very hard in terrible weather conditions.

Hot water in the toilets has been dealt with as the school have now taken the knob off which allows you to adjust the temperature. It is set at the minimum it can be whilst keeping in line with legionella regulations.

The club has received permission to put a sign up under the school signs with home of Hykeham Tigers on. This would be done by Lincoln Signs the same company used by the school to look consistent and as and when the club could afford it.

There can be no training on 13th/14th October as the school are having parents evening and the car park will be too busy.

Martin reported that 2 floodlights are having problems. 1 will be fixed on Monday which is just a replacement battery and the other needs looking at as it has electrical issues. For this week there will only be 2 floodlights available. Tuesday night will be an issue as 3 are needed to light up the field.

Tracy reported that the Halloween party will be going on the website tomorrow and it is now down to managers to push ticket sales. It is being held at the social club behind the memorial hall in Hykeham on Friday 30th October.

The Christmas party will be on Friday 4th December at the Epic Centre and details will be on the website over the next week.

The Lincoln lions have sent details about a bowling night they have organised where each player must raise £25 sponsorship to be split between the club and the Lincoln Lions.

Matt raised a complaint against ML saying he had to re-peg the nets out for the last 4 weeks running. Mike said ML could only do what they could with the facilities given to them and needed stronger pegs.

Jonny asked if the club had received payment from catering yet and Mike said that September's payment would be coming in the next week with a statement but profits are likely to be less than previously due to having to employ somebody from 9am to 5pm every Sunday to do all the setting up and packing away.

Crowd barriers were discussed and managers were asked to keep their substitutes from pulling these down during games. It was suggested that we don't use these and just put a line down instead.
