Minutes of Previous Meeting:

These were previously circulated and accepted as a true reflection of the meeting held Sunday 9th Jan.

Correspondence:

The Secretary advised that more fines have been received for the U10B team (5), this means that the 10B's have now been fined for every league match played this season.
Action >>> MaM to address as matter of urgency.

Treasurers Report:

The treasurer reported that despite best attempts by managers and coaches to reduce outstanding membership debts, there was still a total of £2,467.50 outstanding, which only represents a disappointing 11% reduction of the amount of aged debt. Also there is still bowling monies outstanding.

It was agreed therefore that tougher measures now need to be undertaken starting with a letter being sent direct to parents who have 3 months or over debt outstanding. This would state that unless accounts were brought up to date.. (or arrangements put in place), their child would unfortunately be suspended from all club activity.

Action >>> SW / MWa to agree and send letters.

The bank balance now stands at £8,053.15 .

Club Development:

Outstanding Actions:

Martin advised that a trailer for the floodlights as previously raised, was not really suitable, as weight issues would only add damage to the pitches, and with the number of coaches who should be available to help, would also add an unwarranted cost to the club.

Any Other Business:

Training – All age groups were reminded that there is to be no training at Manor Leas or Fen Lane during the 6 week summer holiday period. Skellingthorpe Road pitches are to be used instead.

From March 3rd The U6 age group will be back training outside at Manor Leas on Thursday evenings from 6 – 7pm.

Presentation Night – It was suggested that buses could be perhaps hired to provide transport to the presentation evening at the Newark Showground. **Action >> MM to investigate if feasible.**

Improved Lighting at Manor Leas – It was suggested that there is a requirement for better lighting at Manor Leas. A Light on the outside of the container and out facing from the refreshment hut would help things immensely during the darker nights, as it is currently difficult locking and packing up without any lighting. Possibly using solar lighting on the container and/or security halogen lighting outside the refreshment hut. **Action >> MWa to investigate.**

Maintenance – The meeting was reminded that all issues / breakages should be reported, not left thinking someone else had done it, as there had recently been a problem with a broken wheel on the diesel caddy, which had not been fixed, as nobody had reported it. If you find something broken, don't assume somebody else has reported it.
