Minutes of Previous Meeting:

Correspondence:

The Secretary reported that Lincolnshire Co-Operative had donated £200 to the Club and that this money had been put towards sponsorship of the U14 team

He also advised that representatives of the club had been invited to and attended a recent Lincoln City match as guests of the F.A to receive both the Clubs F.A Charter standard development award and F.A Volunteer of the year award (Sue Williams - treasurer).

Treasurers Report:

The bank balance currently stands at £7,635, which includes reserves of £1,428. The situation regarding teams and players debts was an improving picture, with plans now in place for most players. Any Other Business:

Steve Lamming raised the issue of the toilets at Manor Leas not being regularly cleaned, both after matches and training. A General discussion entailed regarding the overall standard of cleaning of the toilets from a health and safety perspective.

Mike is to follow up with the school, as it was thought that as part of the Tigers contract with the school, a weekly clean/sanitation routine should be in place.

However it was agreed that all teams, (not just the last playing team of the day), need to undertake a general clean / sweep of the toilet facilities, so that they are of an acceptable standard not only for us but also visiting teams and parents.

Following the outcome of the initial investigation other suggested options were to pay Dominic to clean the toilets each Sunday, or introduce check and sign chart on the wall. **Action >>> MiM**
